Maritime Security Level One Implementation

The Maritime Security Level (MARSEC) has been lowered to MARSEC ONE for all **Maritime Mass Transit Vessels and Facilities** in Northern California effective 2000 hours local time on August 12, 2005. Continue MARSEC ONE security measures for your facilities and vessels as outlined in your approved vessel/facility security plan. Coast Guard security personnel will continue to visit facilities and vessels to verify compliance with security measures.

The Vessel Traffic Service (VTS) is resuming normal operations and all maritime mass transit vessels should resume normal MARSEC ONE VTS procedures. Users are reminded to continue making normal reports on VHF-FM Channel 14 prior to getting underway.

The following Captain of the Port Security Zones remain in effect:

- 25 yard Security Zones around all bridge abutments and piers for both the Golden Gate and Oakland Bay Bridge.
- 100 yard Security Zones around all Cruise Ships, Tank Vessels, and High Interest Vessels.
- 200 yard Security Zone around San Francisco and Oakland International Airports.

The following Naval Protection Zones remain in effect:

- 500 yards around all Naval Vessels
