ANNOUNCEMENT OF PILOT EXAMINATION

Beginning on November 14, 2005 the Washington State Board of Pilotage Commissioners will give an examination in Seattle, Washington to qualified applicants for a state pilot license in the Puget Sound Pilotage District. The written examination will take place on November 14, 2005 and be followed by individual marine simulator evaluations to be scheduled during the remainder of the week (and if necessary into the following week). Applications to sit for the examination may be obtained in person at the offices of the Board at 2901 Third Ave, Seattle, WA 98121 (Floor 1) or may be requested in writing or by email from:

Applications must be completed and filed with the Board on or before 5:00 p.m. on October 17, 2005, unless prior written permission is obtained from the Board to file an application at a later time. At its August 11, 2005 meeting, the Board adopted various amendments and new sections to chapter 363-116 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) affecting qualifications and evaluation of pilot applicants and qualifications and procedures for licensing of marine pilots in the State of Washington. The November examination and licensing process will be governed by and given pursuant to the WAC in effect at the time of the examination which will include the provisions of the new WAC sections and new WAC amendments.
