NOTICE OF ENFORCEMENT OF REGULATIONS FOR FLEETWEEK 2007
OCTOBER 4-7, 2007

Notice is hereby given for the enforcement of special local regulations for marine events, established under Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 100.35, which allows the District Commander to create necessary local regulations to ensure safety of life on the navigable waters immediately prior to, during, and immediately after an approved marine event.

The Coast Guard will be enforcing the regulations in 33 CFR 100.1105 that establish regulated areas in the navigable waters of San Francisco Bay for the annual U.S. Navy and City of San Francisco-sponsored Fleet Week Parade of Navy Ships and Blue Angels Demonstrations to be held on October 4, 2007, through October 7, 2007. Both regulated areas "Alpha" and "Bravo" will include all navigable waters from the surface to the seafloor encompassed by connecting the following points: beginning at 37° 49.113' N, 122° 26.868' W, thence 37° 49.389' N, 122° 24.354' W, thence 37° 48.888' N, 122° 24.272' W, thence 37° 48.612' N, 122° 26.786' W. Regulated area "Alpha" for the Navy Parade of Ships will be enforced from 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on October 6, 2007. Regulated area "Bravo" for the U.S. Navy Blue Angels Activities will be enforced from 11:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on October 4, 2007, and 12:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. on October 5, 2007, through October 7, 2007. If the U.S. Navy Blue Angels Activities are delayed by inclement weather, the regulation will also be enforced on October 8, 2007, from 12:30 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Under the provisions of 33 CFR 100.1105 a vessel may not enter the regulated area, unless it receives permission from the Captain of the Port. Additionally, no person or vessel may enter or remain within 500 yards ahead of the lead Navy parade vessel, within 200 yards astern of the last parade vessel, and within 200 yards on either side of all parade vessels. No person or vessel shall anchor, block, loiter in, or impede the transit of ship parade participants or official patrol vessels.

PENALTY: Persons violating these special local regulations may be liable pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1236.
