




CAPTAIN OF THE PORT SAFETY ZONE NOTICE

Notice is hereby given of a safety zone under Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.7(a), which may not be entered without the prior permission of the Coast Guard Captain of the Port.

The Coast Guard is establishing a temporary safety zone in the navigable waters of San Pablo Bay, CA for Coast Guard Air Station San Francisco Judgmental Flights. This safety zone will apply to navigable waters from the surface to the sea floor in the San Pablo Bay, from 9 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on June 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12, 2009. This temporary safety zone will encompass an area beginning at position 38° 05' 11" N, 122° 22' 10" W; 38° 03' 44" N, 122° 20' 12" W; 38° 00' 41" N, 122° 25' 28" W, 38° 01' 45" N, 122° 26' 38" W (NAD 83). This safety zone is necessary to protect persons and vessels from hazards, injury, and damage associated with the exercises.

Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.23 prohibits any unauthorized person or vessel from entering into, transiting through, or remaining in the safety zone without permission of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. Each person and vessel allowed within a safety zone shall obey any direction or order of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. If the need for the safety zone ends before the scheduled termination time, the Captain of the Port will cease enforcement of the safety zone and will announce that fact via Broadcast Notice to Mariners.

PENALTY: Persons violating these special local regulations may be liable pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1236.
