



CAPTAIN OF THE PORT SAFETY ZONE NOTICE

Notice is hereby given of a safety zone under Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.7(a), which may not be entered without the prior permission of the Coast Guard Captain of the Port.

The Coast Guard is establishing a temporary safety zone in the navigable waters of Lake Tahoe for the July 4th Celebration in South Lake Tahoe, CA. During the loading of the fireworks barge, while the barge is being towed to the display location, and until the start of the fireworks display, the temporary safety zone applies to the navigable waters around and under the fireworks barge within a radius of 100 feet. Fifteen minutes prior to and during the fireworks display, the area to which the temporary safety zone applies will increase in size to encompass the navigable waters around and under the fireworks barge within a radius of 1,000 feet. Loading of the pyrotechnics onto the fireworks barge is scheduled to commence at 9 a.m. on July 4, 2009, and will take place at Jameson Beach, South Lake Tahoe, CA. Towing of the barge from Jameson Beach to the display location is scheduled to take place between 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. During the fireworks display, scheduled to commence at approximately 9:30 p.m., the fireworks barge will be located approximately 1,000 feet off of the shore line of Jameson Beach in position 38° 56'27"N, 120° 02'11"W (NAD 83). The fireworks show is scheduled to last approximately fifteen minutes. The safety zone is effective from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. on July 4, 2009.

Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.23 prohibits any unauthorized person or vessel from entering into, transiting through, or remaining in the safety zone without permission of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. Each person and vessel allowed within the safety zone shall obey any direction or order of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. If the need for the safety zone ends before the scheduled termination time, the Captain of the Port will cease enforcement of the safety zone and will announce that fact via Broadcast Notice to Mariners.

PENALTY: Persons violating this safety zone may be liable pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1232.
