CAPTAIN OF THE PORT SAFETY ZONE NOTICE

Notice is hereby given of a safety zone under Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.7(a), which may not be entered without the prior permission of the Coast Guard Captain of the Port.

The Coast Guard is establishing a temporary safety zone on specified waters off the Santa Cruz Boardwalk Beach, for the Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk Fireworks Spectacular. From 9:10 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on June 13, 2009, the area to which the safety zone applies will encompass the navigable waters around the fireworks launch location within a radius of 1,000 feet. The fireworks display is scheduled to commence at 9:10 p.m. on June 13, 2009, and last approximately twenty minutes. The fireworks launch location will be located at the Santa Cruz Boardwalk Beach in Santa Cruz, CA in position 36[deg]57'50"N, 122[deg]00'51"W (NAD83). This safety zone is effective from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. on June 13, 2009.

Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.23 prohibits any unauthorized person or vessel from entering into, transiting through, or remaining in the safety zone without permission of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. Each person and vessel allowed within the safety zone shall obey any direction or order of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. If the need for the safety zone ends before the scheduled termination time, the Captain of the Port will cease enforcement of the safety zone and will announce that fact via Broadcast Notice to Mariners.

PENALTY: Persons violating this safety zone may be liable pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1232.
