CAPTAIN OF THE PORT SAFETY ZONE NOTICE

Notice is hereby given of a safety zone under Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.7(a), which may not be entered without the prior permission of the Coast Guard Captain of the Port.

The Coast Guard is establishing a temporary safety zone in the navigable waters of San Francisco Bay off of Pier 3, 39 and 43 ½ . Loading of the pyrotechnics onto the barges at Pier 50 is scheduled to commence at 9 a.m. on the 9th and 10th of October, 2009. The fireworks displays are scheduled to commence at 9:30 p.m. on the 9th and 10th of October, 2009, and will last approximately twenty minutes. Upon start, the safety zones will encompass the navigable waters around the fireworks launch location within a radius of 1000 ft. The fireworks launch locations will be located in positions: 37° 47'55.61"N, 122° 23'36.03"W (NAD 83), 37° 48'41.95"N, 122° 24'43.97"W (NAD 83), and 37° 48'38.00"N, 122° 24'50.93"W. The fireworks display is scheduled to last approximately twenty minutes. This safety zone is effective from 8:45 a.m. to 10 p.m. on the 9th and 10th of October, 2009.

Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.23 prohibits any unauthorized person or vessel from entering into, transiting through, or remaining in the safety zone without permission of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. Each person and vessel allowed within the safety zone shall obey any direction or order of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. If the need for the safety zone ends before the scheduled termination time, the Captain of the Port will cease enforcement of the safety zone and will announce that fact via Broadcast Notice to Mariners.

PENALTY: Persons violating this safety zone may be liable pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1232.
