Solicitation for Area Maritime Security Committee Membership

The Captain of the Port, San Francisco, is soliciting for interested persons to participate in the Area Maritime Security Committee for the following four positions:

- Maritime Labor Representative,
- County Government Representative,
- Cargo Terminal/Shipping Representative, and
- Ferryboat Industry Representative.

Prospective members must have five years experience in their segment of maritime industry, particularly in operations and/or security; are willing to serve on the Committee for three years; sign a Federal Non-disclosure Agreement to receive Sensitive Security Information; register as a user in the Coast Guard's HOMEPORT internet information portal; and be available to advise the Captain of the Port about port security/operations issues. The Area Maritime Security Committee and its members are governed by the regulations contained in Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations part 103 (Area Maritime Security Committee) and Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations part 1520 (Sensitive Security Information).

To apply, prospective members must submit a letter to the Captain of the Port stating their qualifications, background, and willingness to serve on the Committee. Letters must be submitted to the Captain of the Port not later than December 15, 2007 to: Commander, USCG Sector San Francisco, 1 Yerba Buena Island, San Francisco, CA 94130.
