How to do Business with the United Nations

Highlights

Track two will be a special feature of this seminar and will focus only on the UN headquarters building renovation.

UN Buyers from the six participating UN agencies will review your company profile. Meet with the buyers that have selected your company as suitable for UN procurement.

Finally, you will be treated to a lunch and evening networking reception where you will have the opportunity to meet with the UN Procurement officials and your fellow seminar participants in an informal setting.
